

The Shirley K. Sullivan Education Fund Grant terms/conditions:

1. Allows all active cooperative communicators and the CCA regions to apply for grants.
2. Educational programs eligible for funding include, but are not limited to, regional CCA workshops, CCA Annual Institute, national cooperative education programs (NICE, GICL, etc.) and other opportunities which advance skills and knowledge in the field of cooperative communications.
3. Grant size/number of grants offered will be based on need, merit, and amount of funding available.
4. Individuals may receive a grant no more frequently than once per calendar year. An organization may receive a grant in two successive years, but must then wait a year before applying again.
5. Upon completion of the education program, awardees must submit a brief report on the value of their educational experience, along with appropriate expense receipts for grant funding to be released.
